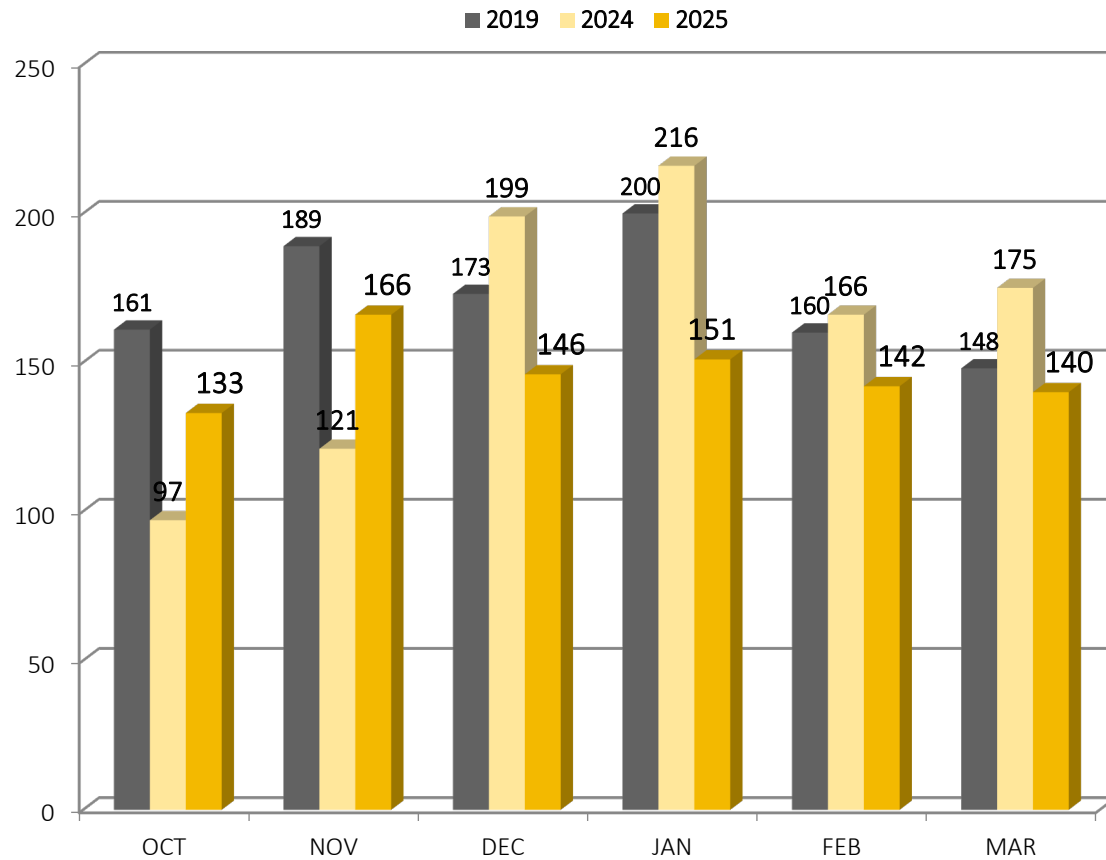

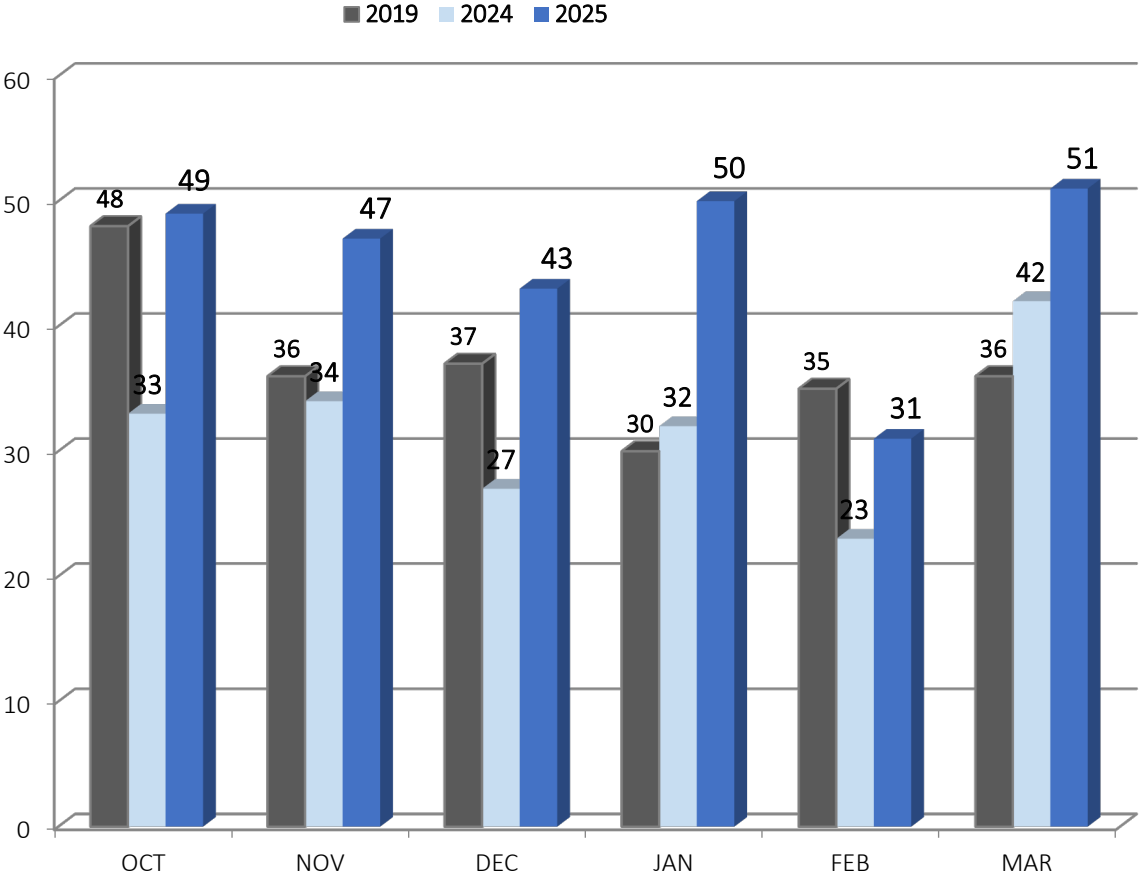

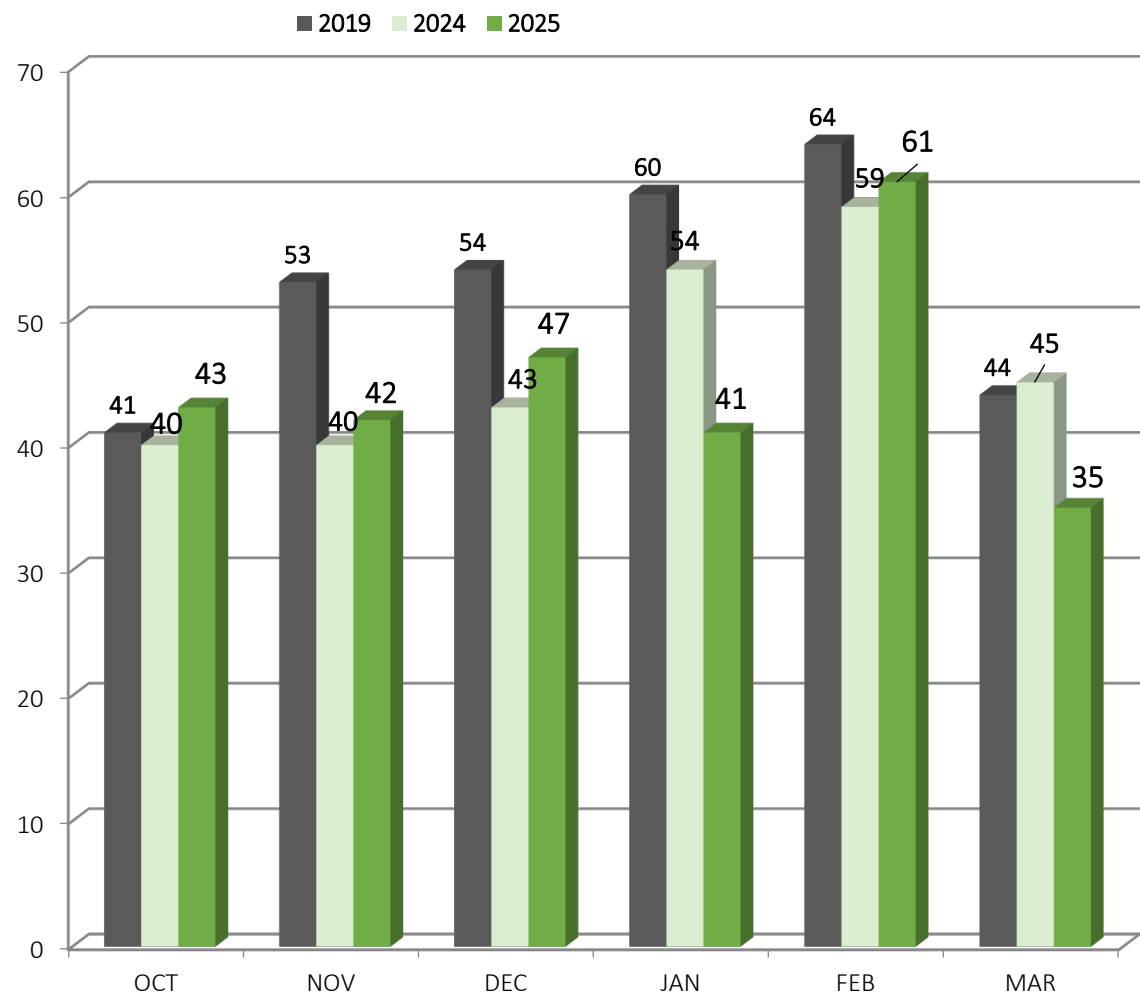

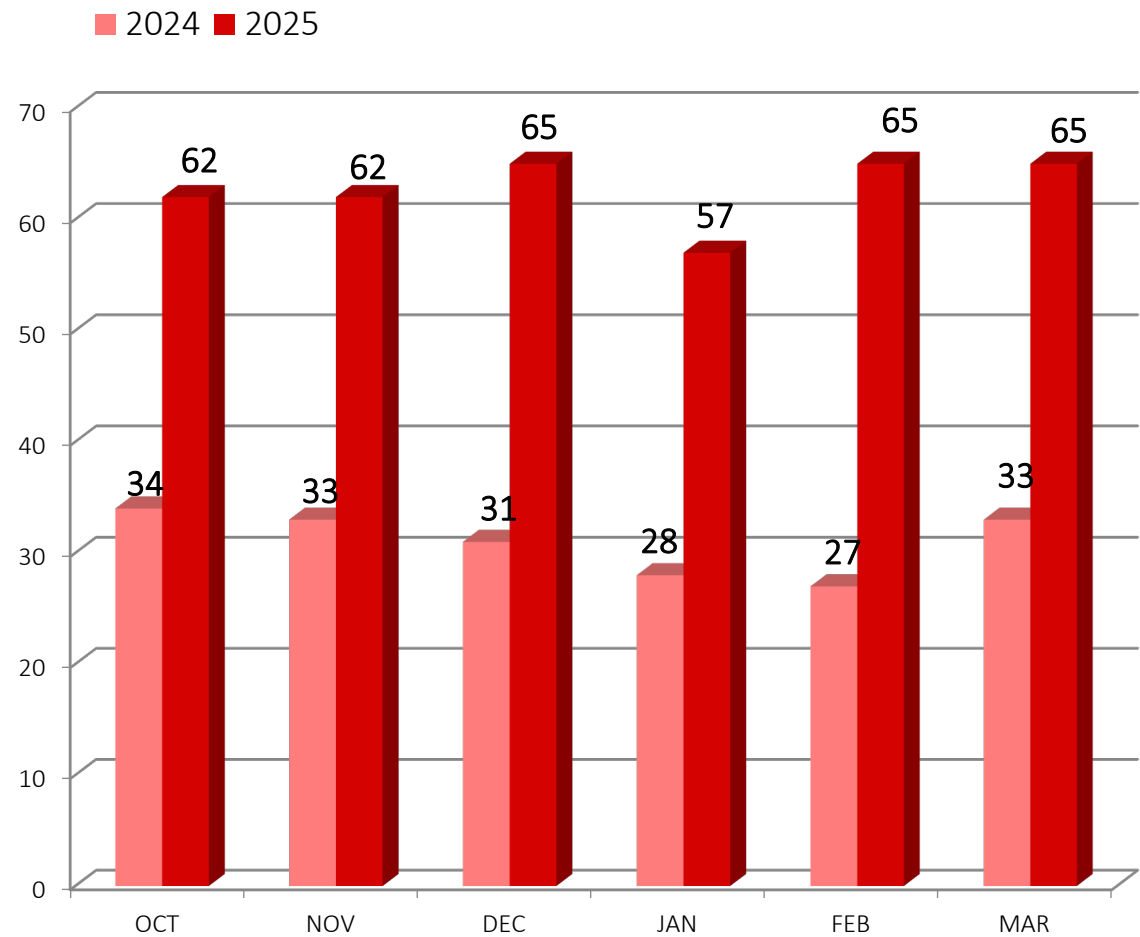

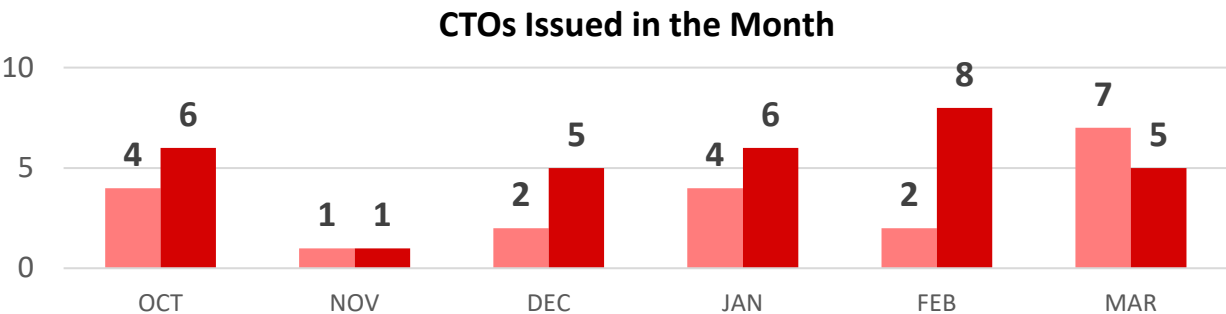

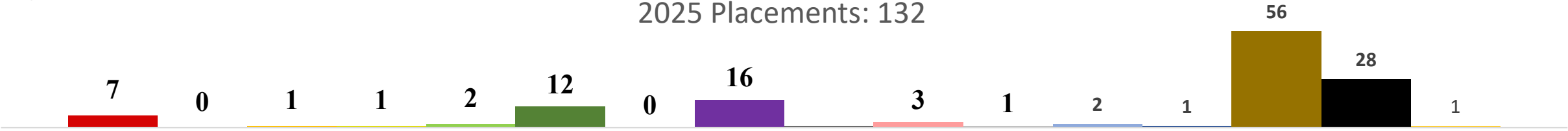

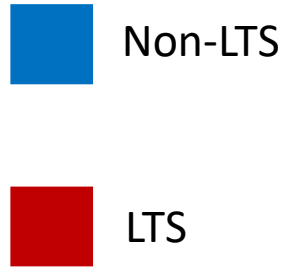

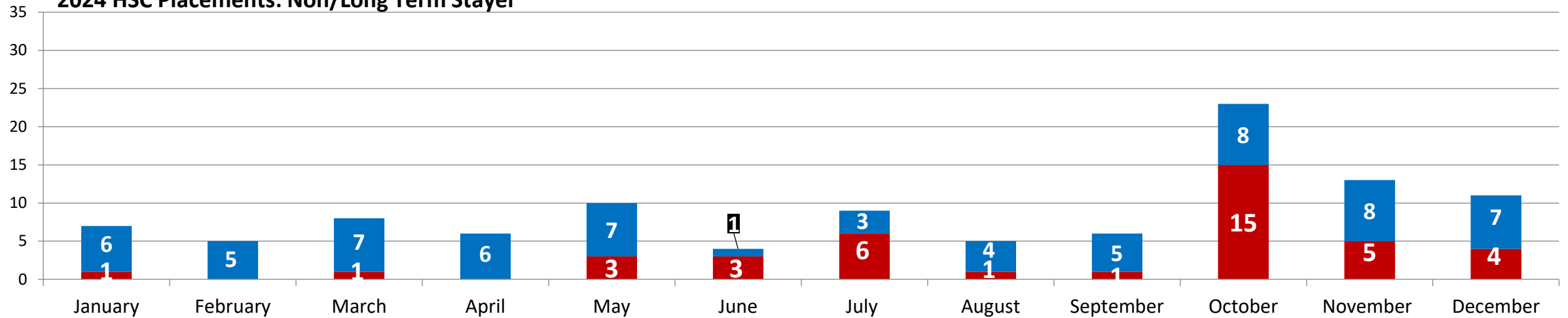

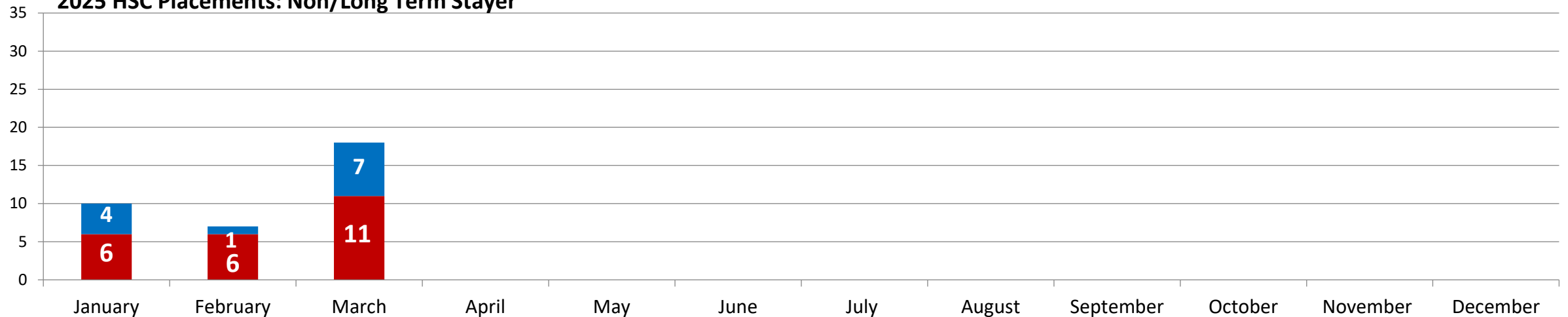
HOMELESS SERVICES CENTER & COMMUNITY OVERFLOW HOUSING PLACEMENT DATA



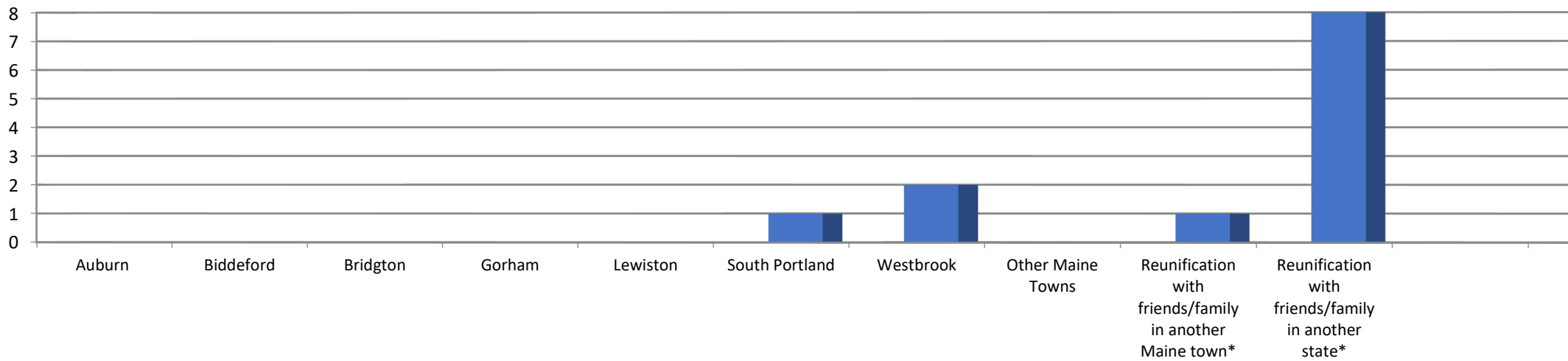
2024 HSC Placements: Non/Long Term Stayer



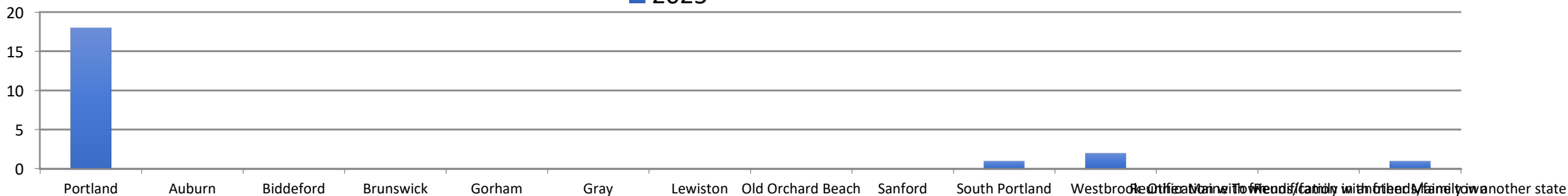
2025 HSC Placements: Non/Long Term Stayer
