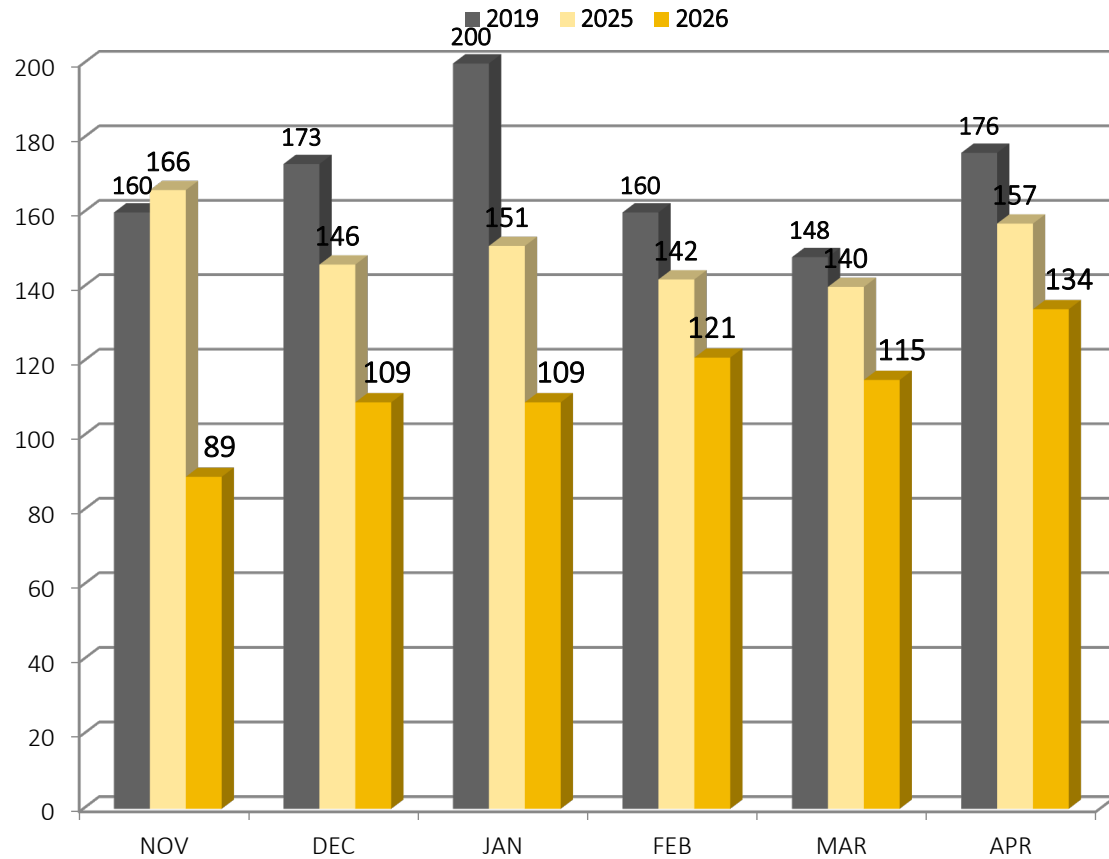

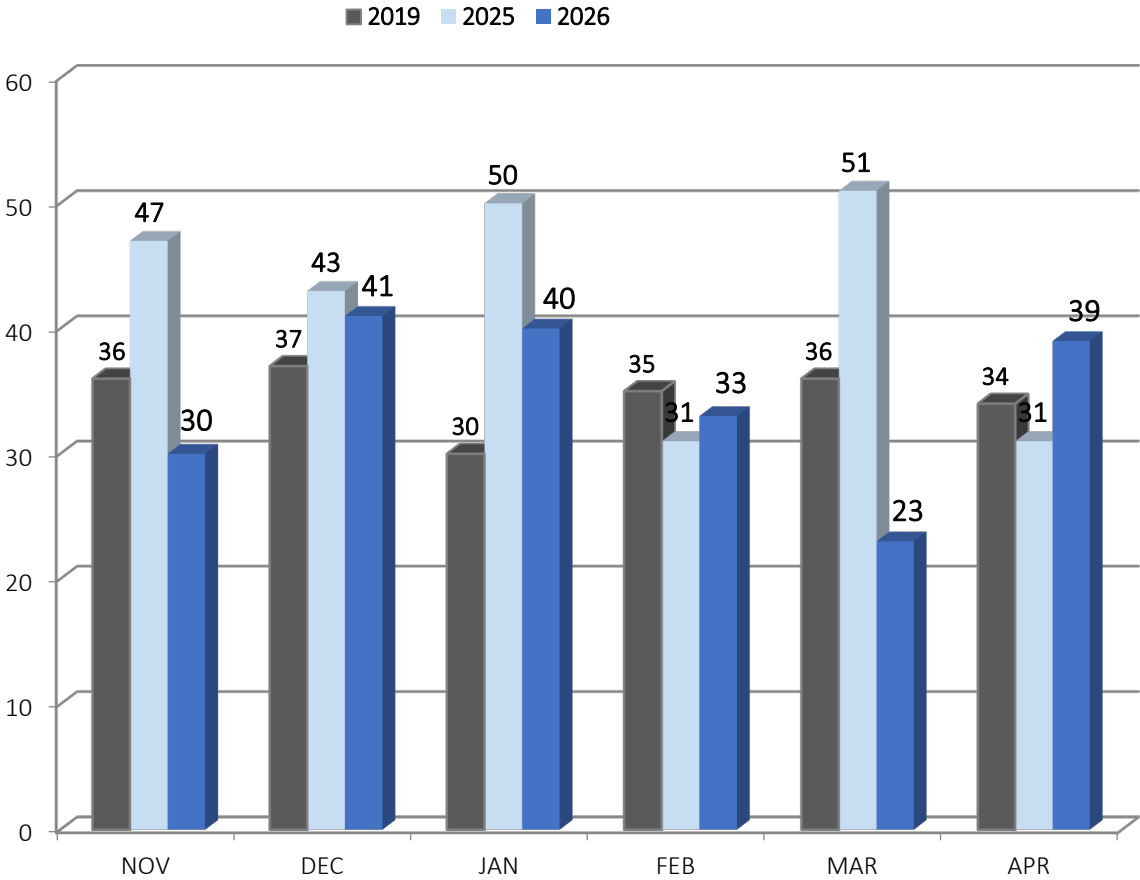

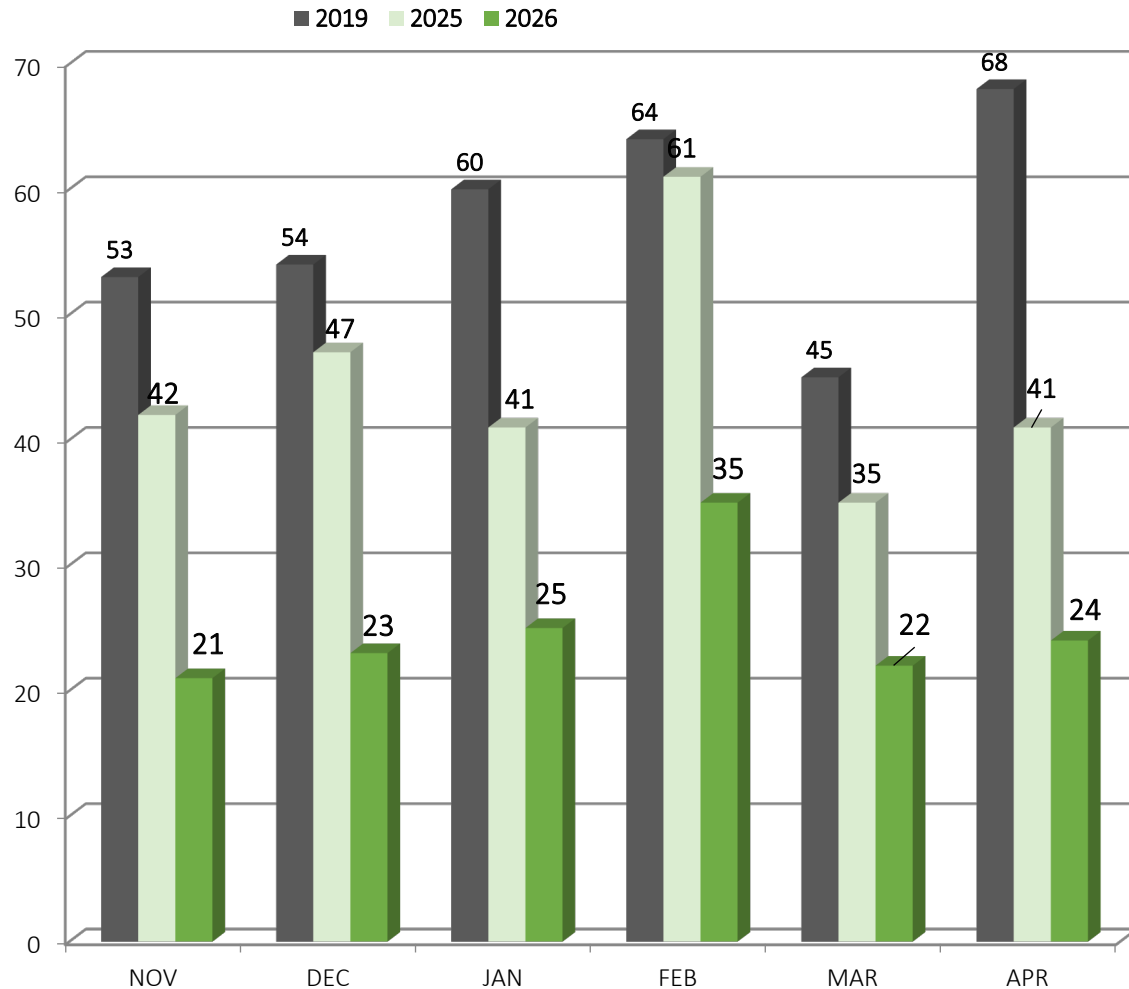

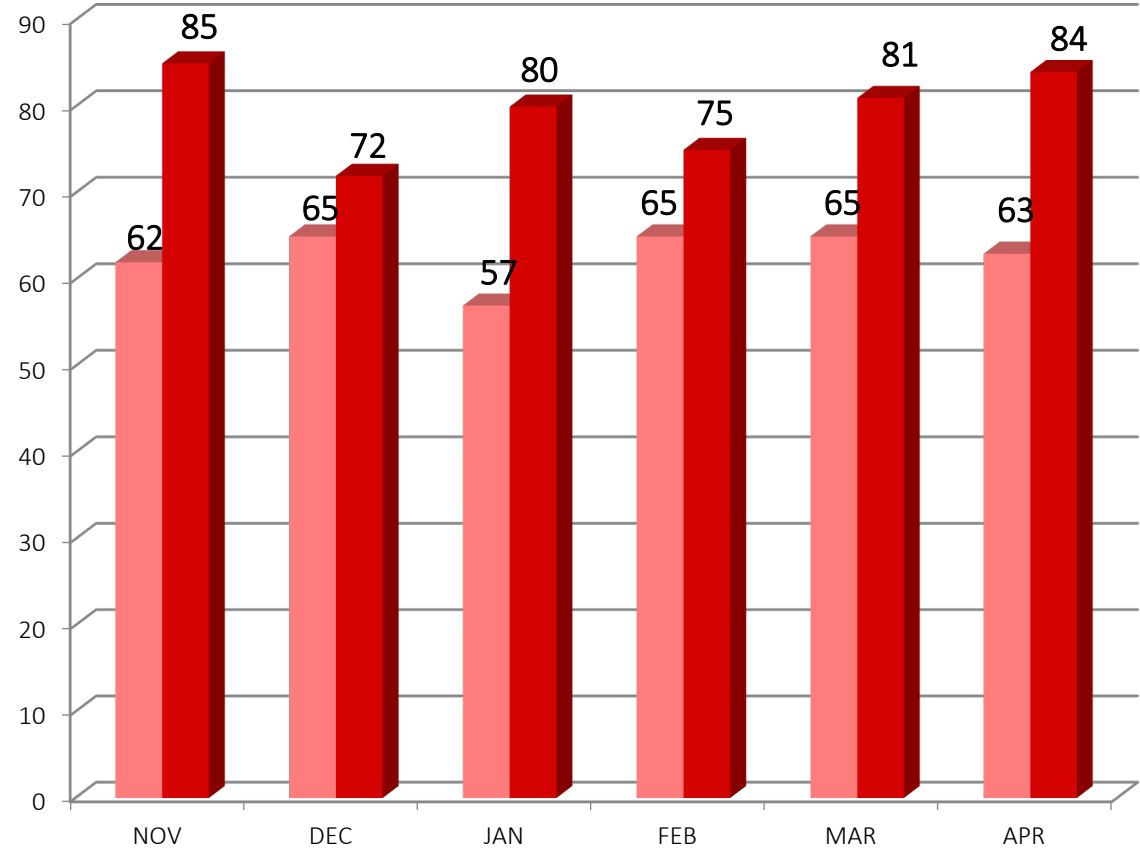

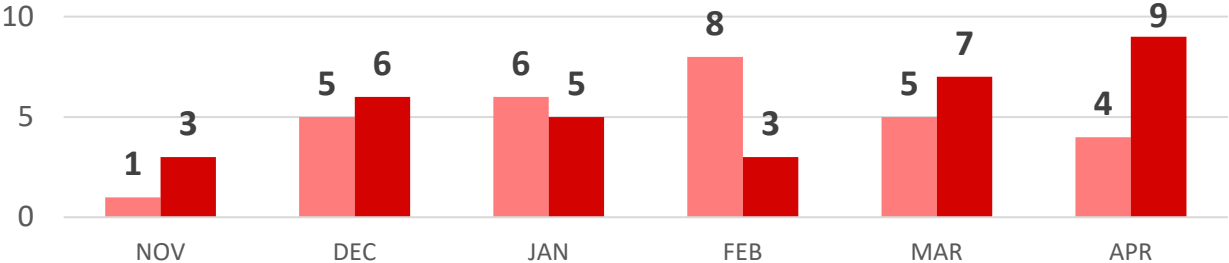

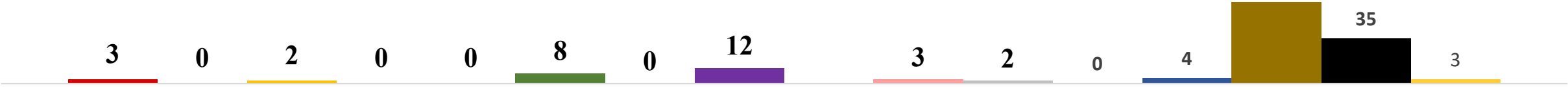

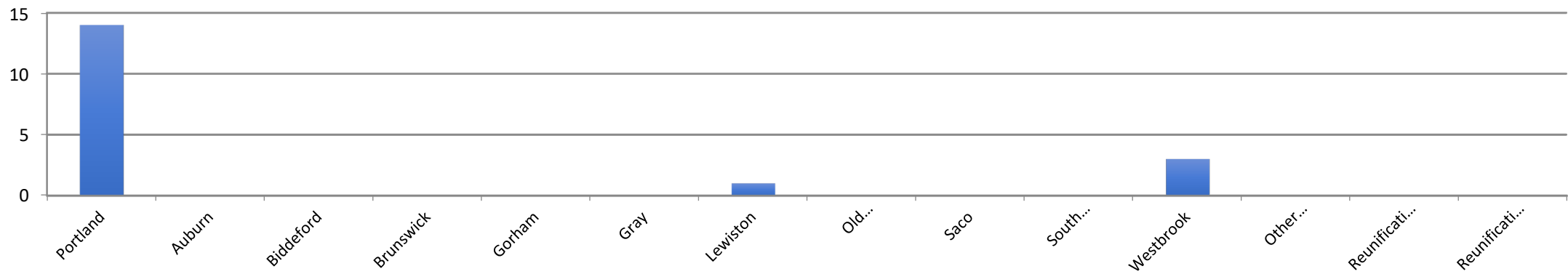


The Fifteen LTS placements collectively represent 7,616 bed nights, nearly 21 years of homelessness.
